Language Arts:

Please complete ONE journal entry this week. Respond to the following prompt: Have you noticed any changes in your life/day-to-day activities/surroundings since Alberta opened stage 1 of its relaunch strategy? See the ASSIGNMENT in TEAMS for more details.

This is your final week of poetry! Read through the content and the poems on slides 20-30 in the Poetry PowerPoint (attached to the assignment in Teams). There are 4 types of poems you can choose from for your final assignment. You will choose 3 of the 4 to write and submit to me by Friday. I can't wait to read your lovely words!

Social Studies:

This week we are reviewing a unit for 6A and 6B and starting a new unit for 6C and 6D. The unit is about the Iroquois Confederacy. The Iroquois had a form of government that is different than Ancient Greece and Canada today and you will be either learning about the type of government the Iroquois had, or comparing the three different types. All students will have a booklet to work on. Please read the instruction on Teams carefully and let us know if you have any questions.

Math:

This week you will work through two lessons on Probability. These are the only two lessons you will be completing on this topic.

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Science:

This week you will learn about the four forces of flight, focusing on gravity, weight and drag.
